Physical features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe physical features of Yorkshire; comparing those of Sheffield to the Peak District. Use geographical language to refer and gain an understanding of vegetation belts, mountains, hills, rivers, dams and caves (Blue John) and distribution of natural materials between Sheffield and Castleton? 	
Human features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compare and explore types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources between Sheffield and The Peak District. 	
Fieldwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods, including sketch maps, plans and graphs, and digital technologies. Use maps, atlases, globes and digital computer mapping to locate England within the UK and then Yorkshire within England. Use maps, atlases globes and digital computer mapping to locate some counties of the UK, and the city of Sheffield within Yorkshire, The Peak District and significant hills and mountains of the UK.
